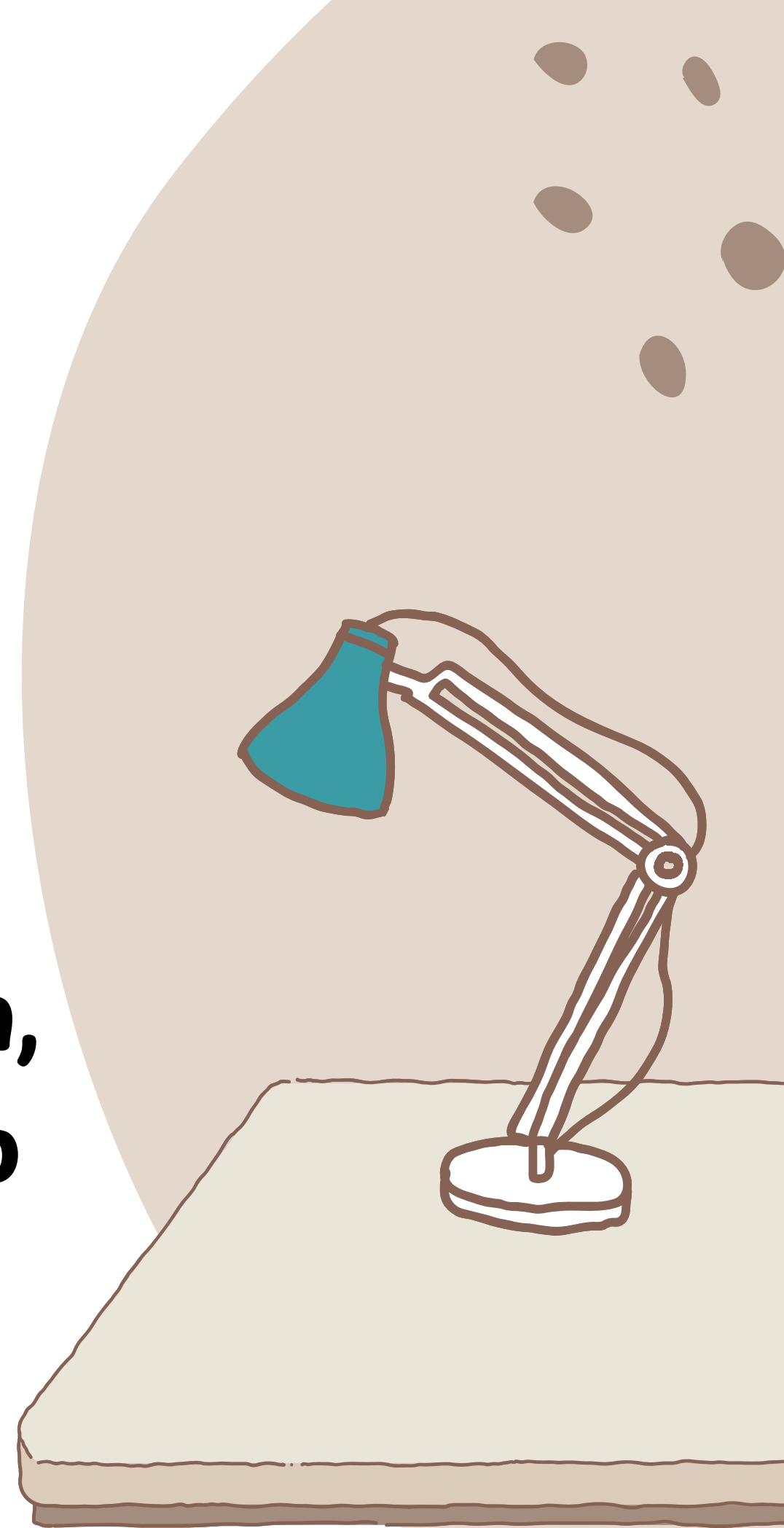
This Is My Family

Math Intervention

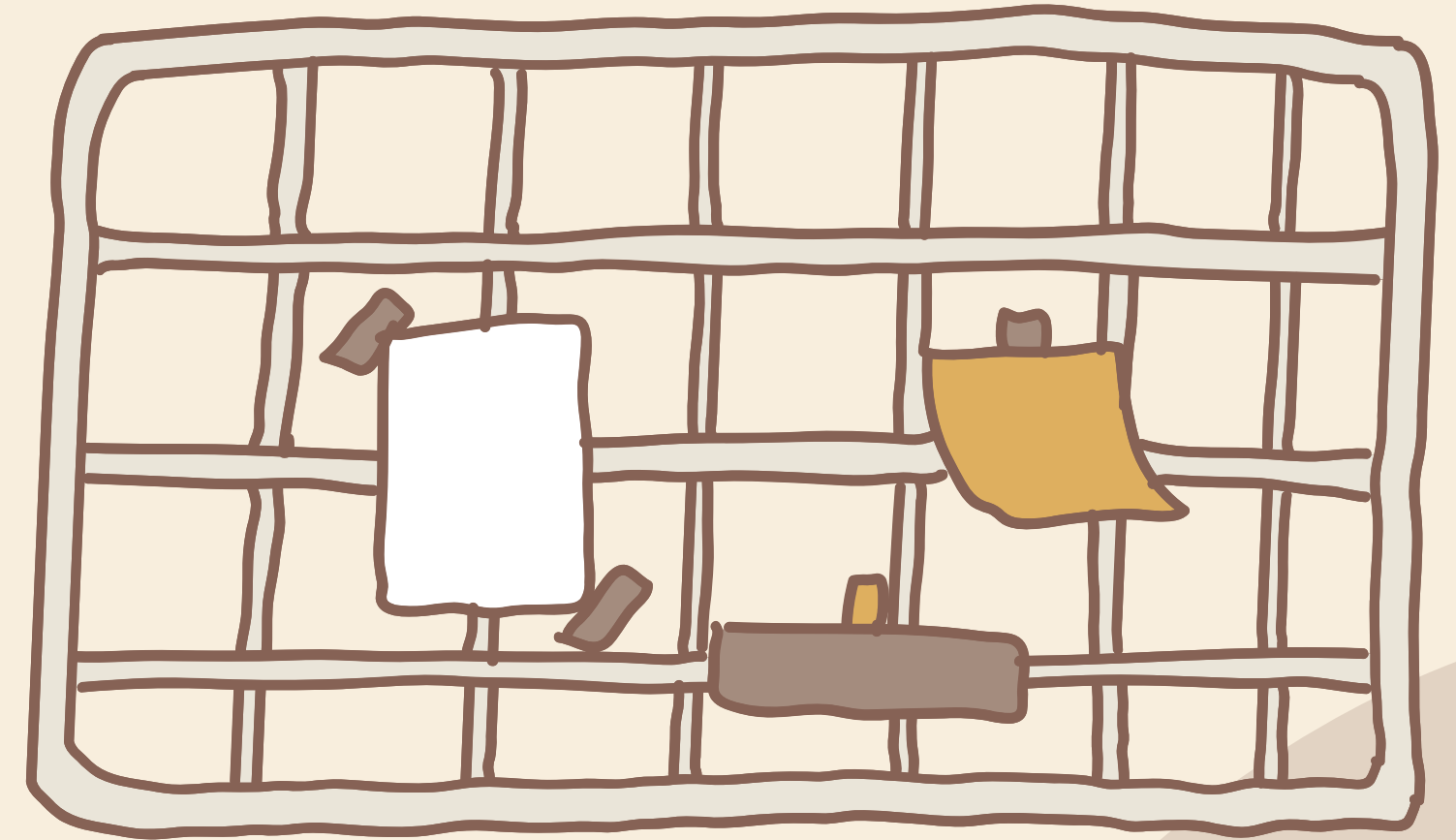
Targeted instructional strategies designed to build foundational number sense and problem-solving confidence for every middle school student.
